RULES

- Negative coggins and rabies certificates within 1 year required.
- Stallions must be handled by a qualified adult.
- Youth =18 and under.
- All classes are open to horses and ponies.
- All classes will award ribbons 1st-6th place.
- Formal attire and braiding is welcome but not required. Horse and rider tack and attire should be clean, tidy, and properly adjusted for safety. SEI APPROVED HELMETS with properly adjusted chin strap is REQUIRED in all mounted classes, whether English or Western.
- Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes as entries warrant, and change the show schedule if it becomes necessary.
- Vet and farrier will be on call, EMT on grounds.
- Horses may only be ridden by those who have signed the appropriate entry blank and signed a GMHA and HRC waiver.
- Each horse and rider combination needs a separate number.
- Trot/jog riders may not enter any canter/lope classes.
- A horse or pony may show only once in each class
- Judge's decisions are final.
- Western horses may NOT use martingales, tie downs, mechanical hackamores, drop

nose bands, draw reins or leg wraps.

- English horses may use boots or martingales.
- If your horses is a known kicker, place a red ribbon in its tail.
- Unruly horses and/or any person mistreating any horse will be dismissed from the class and/or showgrounds.
- Scratches and/or no shows to a class will not be refunded. Late add classes permitted at no additional charge and must be paid in the show office at that time with a check or cash. Bounced checks will incur a \$35 insufficient funds fee.
- Stabling: All stalls must be stripped upon departure (all shavings, manure & wet bedding removed & swept clean). Competitors will be billed \$50 for leaving a dirty stall.
- Bedding for stalls will not be provided

Class Specifications

Fitting and Showmanship: Open to all horses and ponies, to be judged on the competitor's ability to properly groom_and prepare the horse to be judged, and their showmanship performance during the class. To be shown on the lead, halter and lead rope or bridle acceptable; no other tack or

equipment allowed. Exhibitors will show the horse in the arena as per the judge's instructions.

Lead Line: Open to riders 9 and under. To be shown at the walk, with a short trot or jog. Not to cross-enter in any class other than Lead Line designated classes. May be shown in English or Western attire. Simon Says class will include fun additional instructions from the judge.

Equitation: To be shown at the walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope as designated by the class, both directions. The judge may provide additional requests. To be judged on hands, seat and control of the horse. May be asked to back.

<u>Pleasure:</u> To be shown at the walk, trot/jog, canter/lope, as designated by the class, both directions. The judge may provide additional requests. May be asked to back. To be judged on performance, manners, soundness and the horse's suitability to serve as a pleasure mount.

<u>Trail:</u> Open to all riders, to be shown individually through a course of 6-8 trail obstacles (may include mailbox, bridge, backing over rails, small jump, water crossing). Maybe shown in English or Western attire.

<u>Costume Class</u>: Open to ALL ages, horses, and ponies. Mounted or unmounted at the walk only. Get creative and show us your best costume for you and your mount! May be shown in English or Western attire.

Simon Says: Judged on the horse and rider's ability to follow the announcer's instructions. Judge calls out commands (change of gait, direction, halt, rein-back, etc.), exhibitor must obey commands only IF "Simon Says". Class continues until one horse remains. Commands appropriate to the level for each class. May be shown in English or Western attire.

<u>Sit-A-Buck:</u> Riders will be given a piece of paper (or dollar bill) to place in between their seat and their saddle (or no saddle in the bareback class), and it must be visible to the judge. The riders will have to go through a series of ridden commands and the winner will be the rider who is able to keep the paper/dollar from falling. Walk, trot, canter. May be shown in English or Western attire.

Jumper Classes: Table 2b, untimed first round, timed shortened jump off round immediately following a clear round.

Championships awarded in Leadline, Overall Walk Trot Youth and Adult, and Overall W/T/C Youth and Adult (points from fitting and showmanship, pleasure, equitation and trail to be included) Youth = 18 or under
